Further to your meeting with Alex Cieslewicz, on behalf of the Richard Lake Stewardship, we look forward to forming a good working relationship with yourself and UNIFOR Local 598.

*As you are probably aware, the Richard Lake Stewardship Mandate is: "To preserve, protect, restore and improve the natural resources and the environment of Richard Lake. The Richard Lake Stewardship Committee would like to promote conservation, restoration and sustainable use of the lake through meetings, gatherings and education of all lake residents and members of the subsequent watershed including McFarlane Lake, Long Lake and Lake Panache."*

One of the ways we hope to promote our mandate is through partnerships with others such as UNIFOR, who also have an interest in preserving the environment and, in this case, Richard Lake as well. The Richard Lake Stewardship Committee (RLSC) has set up a web site ([www.richardlake.ca](http://www.richardlake.ca)) to post information on ways to help us reach the goals of our mandate and keep interested parties as informed as possible of the lake activities. To encourage people to access the web site, the RLSC would like to propose a UNIFOR 598/Richard Lake Photo Contest. The Photo Contest would be held over a number of months in 2015 to display the beauty of Richard Lake and highlight UNIFOR's involvement, while encouraging use of the web site. The winning photo, as judged by a couple of selected judges, could then be submitted to the city wide "City of Lakes Photo Contest" which in turn could be selected for the annual calendar.

The RLSC would like to request \$300 from UNIFOR to help us present prizes for the contest, which has currently been proposed as: \$250 First Prize, \$100 Second Prize and \$50 Third Prize, meaning the RLSC will also donate \$100.
