On Monday, June 20th, 2016, Sudbury Mine, Mill & Smelter Workers' Union, Local 598/Unifor will be holding its 32rd annual Worker's Memorial Day Service.

On June 20th, 1985, the first Worker's Memorial Day Service was held in remembrance of four of our members who had tragically lost their lives in a fall of ground one year earlier. The four members were Sulo Korpela, Danielle Lavellee, Richard Chenier and Wayne St. Michel. The service has been expanded to remember all those who have lost their lives due to an on-the-job accident or an industrial disease.

The service is open to the general public and will be held at Richard Lake Campground located at 2550 Richard Lake Road, Sudbury and will begin at 9:30 a.m.

Following the service, a light lunch will be served. Following the lunch, we will be honouring a historic union activist, Joe Hill in a brief burial service where a portion of his ashes will be buried near the cenotaph.
