After a meeting and ratification vote on Thursday, September 29th, 2011, the members at Iris Addiction Recovery for Women ratified and accepted the new contract. The contract was to expire on September 30th, 2011.

Some gains in the new contract include signing bonuses and a pay increase, along with contract language improvement.

This is Mine Mill Local 598/CAW's 13th consecutive collective agreement reached successfully in the last 2 years.

Mine Mill Local 598/CAW is currently also in negotiations with the Elizabeth Centre, Finlandia Nursing Home, St. Joseph's Villa and St. Gabriel's Villa. Starting shortly, talks will begin with The Walford on the Park.
