



OLG Negotiation Update

May 29, 2011

To Our Fellow Co-Workers

We would like to take this opportunity to update everyone on negotiations between Mine Mill 598/CAW and OLG.

The Company and the Union began negotiations on April 20th in Kitchener with opening proposal exchange. At that time, it was agreed that each respective site (Sudbury, Brantford and Woodbine) would try to speed up the process by dealing with the non monetary language issues in their respective cities. This was done at the Holiday Inn in Sudbury during the week of May 2nd to May 6th. During that session of bargaining, we had some very fruitful discussions regarding our local issues and concerns. Mine Mill 598/CAW and OLG were also very determined in resolving all outstanding grievances. We were successful in settling all outstanding grievances to date.

Since May 26th, 2011, negotiations have now moved to Toronto where the three Bargaining Committees have discussed common issues amongst all three sites. Some progress has been achieved in that regard.

We are committed and determined in reaching a new and fair Collective Agreement for each site and because of this we have all agreed **to continue negotiating past the May 31, 2011, expiry of the current Collective Agreement.**

As of today, neither CAW nor OLG have filed for Conciliation therefore, we have not set a definitive time line to cease negotiations as long as the lines of communication remain open.

We will endeavor to keep you updated on our progress, and thank you for your continued support.
